

ELIGIBILITY FOR CYO TEAM SPORTS AT ST. ANSELM SCHOOL

St. Anselm CYO team sports are: Soccer, Basketball, Baseball/Softball & Cheerleading

1) Academic:

a. A student must achieve a minimum grade of "C" (2.0) in the following:

RELIGION	SOCIAL STUDIES	SCIENCE	ENGLISH
MATH	READING	SPELLING	

b. A student must receive a minimum grade of a "C" in conduct in all classes.

There can be no recorded F in any subject.

c. If a student's grades fall below this level the following guidelines will be taken:

ACADEMIC PROBATION GUIDELINES

1. Academic probation will be enforced at the first progress report date.
2. If a student's grade drops below a 2.0 in any core subject, including conduct, a two week probation period begins.
3. During this two week period, a student may practice not play, but must show improvement in the area of concern.
4. At the end of the two week period, if improvement is evident, the student is clear to play. If improvement has not been shown, the student will not be allowed to participate in sports including practices and games for two weeks.
5. After the second two week period, if no improvement has occurred, the student will be dismissed from the team for the remainder of the season.
6. The first two weeks probation period is only given once. If grades or conduct fall a second time, the student will be on Academic Probation 2, as stated in point 4 above.

2) Suspension:

The Athletic Director will be notified in the event that a student has been suspended in school or from school because of an infraction occurring in school. In this case, a student should be removed from practice and participation for a directed period of time.

3) Health:

Any student who, due to doctor's orders and/or chronic health condition, is unable to regularly participate in gym class, is not eligible for St. Anselm team sports. All students participating in interscholastic sports must have a annual physical examination form on file.

4) Tuition:

In the event that tuition has not been paid or is not up to date at the time of registration for a sport, the office will hold registration. The students' name will not be recorded on the roster which means the student will be ineligible to participate in a scheduled game. Once tuition is paid, the student will be added to the roster.
